





## CODE OF CONDUCT YOUTH COACHES

- Ensure you always work within the RFU guidelines, Continuum and Club Child Protection Policy.
- Be reasonable in your demands on young players time energy and enthusiasm remember that they have other interests.
- Teach your players that the laws of the game are mutual agreements which no-one should break.
- Avoid over-playing the talented players the 'just average' players need and deserve equal time.
- Children play for fun winning is only part of it never yell at or ridicule children for making mistakes or loosing.
- Follow the advice of a doctor in determining when an injured player is ready to play again.
- Gain respect by being generous with your praise when it is deserved.
- Improve young players through coaching frequent match-play or long practice sessions do not guarantee development.
- Avoid mismatches it does not help either side if one team runs up a 'cricket score' – stop the game and evenup the teams.
- DO NOT SHOUT CONTINUALLY use your voice as a tool.





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
